**By asking the right questions.** The AI Opportunity Canvas helps teams systematically develop ideas for applying AI – focusing on value and feasibility. As a strategic tool, it reveals potential opportunities and fosters a shared understanding of how to approach AI.

#### How to work with the Canvas

The Canvas is designed to guide you step by step through five areas. Each section poses a guiding question that helps you sharpen your topic and think it through in a structured way:

- 1. Domain: In which area or process are you working?
- 2. Journey: What value do you want to unlock, or which inefficiencies do you want to eliminate?
- 3. Ideation: Which AI approaches could make the biggest difference here?
- 4. Impact: What value would the solution create—for users, teams, or the business?
- 5. Roadmap: What next steps are realistic to validate or implement the idea?

Capture your answers in the **Al Opportunity Worksheet**. It helps structure your thinking and makes ideas comparable. Use one worksheet per idea or scenario - this keeps the focus clear and makes it easier to prioritize results. # **Al Opportunity Canvas**



The AI Opportunity Canvas helps teams systematically explore and structure potential applications of AI.

#### 1 Domain

Clarify what you are focusing on. Describe the relevant process or customer journey. Identify the key stakeholders and outline the strategic goals or challenges you aim to tackle with AI.

- Which process or journey are you focusing on?
- · Who is involved or impacted?
- What tasks or goals define this area?
- What strategic challenges or success metrics are at play?
- Why is this topic worth a closer look?

### 2 Journey

Model your process as a (customer) journey with actors, activities, and tasks – then identify the key points where Al could potentially be applied.

- What steps does the journey include from start to finish?
- · Who is involved at each stage?
- · What activities or tasks take place?
- Where do handovers, decisions, or bottlenecks occur?
- Which processes are especially important or critical to overall success?

#### 3 Ideation

Develop concrete solution approaches for the identified opportunities. Consider which AI technologies and methods could help address the challenges. Describe the core functionality of your idea and outline how it could be integrated into the existing process or customer journey. Stay open to different approaches and prioritize feasibility.

- Which AI capabilities (e.g. text processing, image recognition, prediction, automation) could your ideas draw on?
- What exactly should the AI solution do, and how does it solve the problem?
- How does the solution fit into existing systems and workflows?
- Are there similar solutions or best practices you can learn from?
- What technical or organizational challenges might you encounter?

### 4 Impact

Evaluate the effort and benefits of your ideas, prioritize them based on feasibility and impact, and choose the scenario with the greatest potential.

- · Which idea offers the most value or benefit?
- · How much effort would implementation require?
- · Which idea seems most feasible?
- Where would the biggest impact be for customers, users, or the company?
- · Which idea would you like to move forward with?

### **5 Roadmap**

Define concrete next steps to turn your selected AI opportunity into an actionable project.

- What steps do you need to take to validate or test your idea?
- What data, resources, or partners will you need?
- Where can you find quick wins or launch initial pilots?
- · What risks or dependencies should you keep in mind?
- · What does a realistic timeline look like?

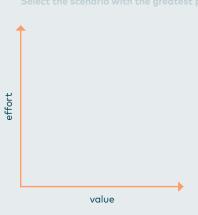
